

When using the OtterPR logo, follow the dimensions recorded below. The full symbol and word logo will be the main display across digital and print platforms.




The Colors


Flamingo


The Gradient

Only use gradients as background and on typography that contrasts over a 3:1 ratio.



Gradient Usage

Gradients should only be applied with white as the contrasting color. NEVER use the gradient with anything other than pure white



Spacing

For maximum legibility, use logo, headings and body paragraphs with lenient white space.



Color Palletes and Variations

The OtterPR logo can be used on high contrast solid color backgrounds. The four main brand colors can be combined with one another to create new components and flourishes.



Photo Backgrounds

When using OtterPR's logo on photos, ensure that the direct color behind the logo provides enough contrast.

NEVER place a colored OtterPR logo on any non-solid color backgrounds.

NEVER place a white OtterPR logo on busy and badly contrasted backgrounds.
